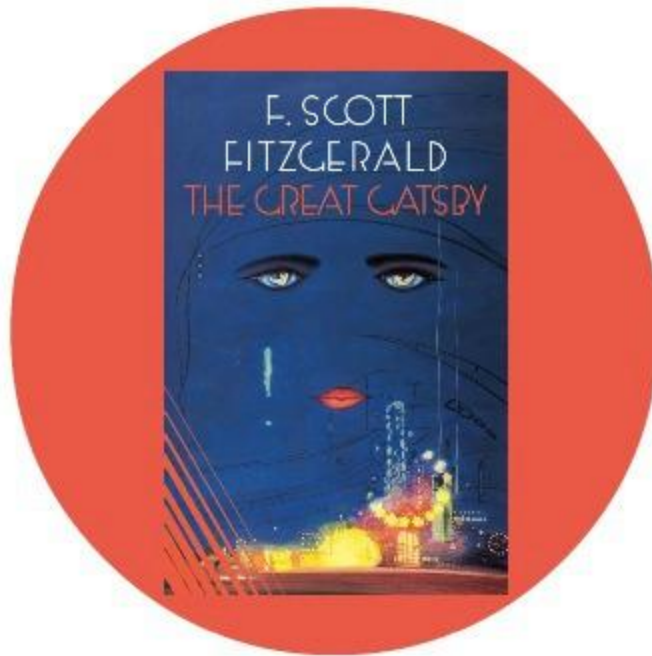

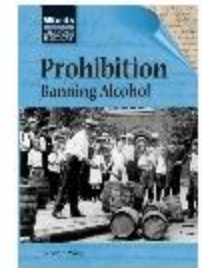


Quick Facts

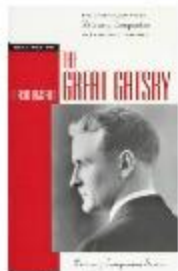

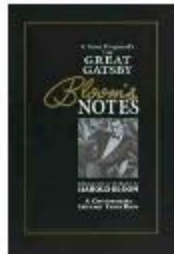

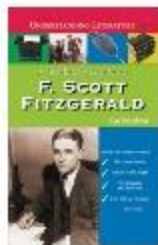
